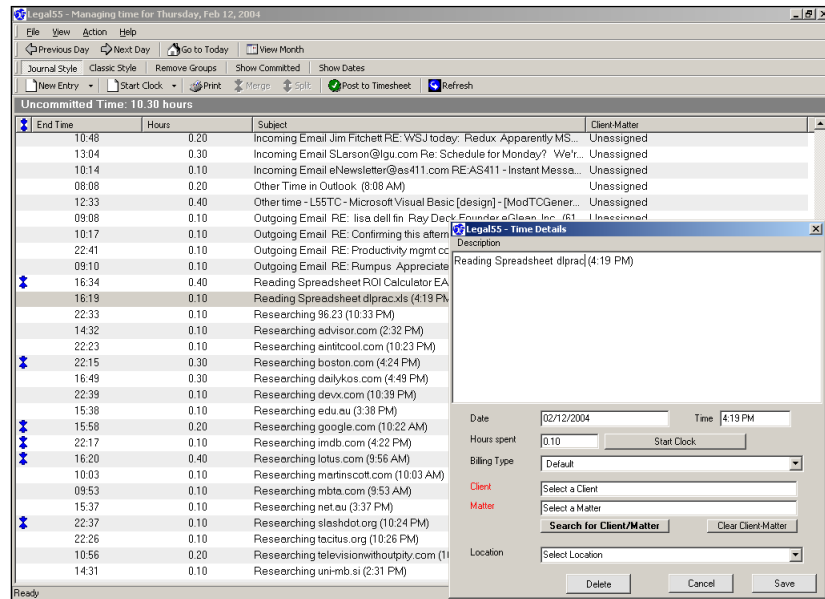




Capture More Billable Hours

Legal55 captures time that professionals spend throughout the business day. From when the computer turns on in the morning until the end of the day, Legal55 captures information in the background related to time spend on the computer, phone, in scheduled meetings, and even “other” time.

The system provides useful descriptions of the activities and, in many cases, automatically allocates items to appropriate clients and matters, asking the timekeeper to confirm that the “guess” was correct.

<p>Telephone Time</p>	<p>Legal55 automatically captures time spent on incoming and outgoing calls, and ties them to the phone number. The provided server utilizes a serial connection to the SMDR or CDR output of the internal telephone system.</p> <p>If available, the phone number is associated with a contact in Outlook or Lotus Notes to provide better information on who the conversation was with.</p>
<p>Appointment Time</p>	<p>Appointments recorded through Microsoft Outlook or Lotus Notes are captured as activities for attribution to the timesheet.</p>
<p>Integration with Knowledge Management</p>	<p>Legal55 integrates with major document and contact management systems from Interaction, Worldox, Hummingbird, Imanage and others to add descriptive information and client/matter attributions to activities throughout the day.</p>
<p>“Other” time</p>	<p>Idle time and time spent on “other” applications is captured as it arises</p>
